## Leadership Roles for Student Groups

For each student presentation module, five students will sign up for a specific leadership role in addition to working on group tasks. These roles consist of:

- 1. **Welcomer and Summarizer**: On Monday when the module begins, this person welcomes the class to the module and highlights the content, presentations, activities, and assignments. On Sunday evening when the module ends, this person also summarizes what occurred in the module.
- 2. **Lead Presentation Designer**: Combines materials from all members of the group to create a presentation.
- 3. **Objectives Guru**: Creates the objectives for the module with input from other members of the group, checks that objectives match the assessment, and shares the objectives with the class.
- 4. **Assessment Guru**: Designs the assessment activity (artifact) for the module, works with the Objectives Guru to make sure it aligns with the objectives, and collects feedback from class members about the assessment.
- 5. **Discussion leader**: Designs the discussion questions that are aligned with objectives, coordinates the moderation of the discussion by group members, and summarizes the main points in the discussion at the end of the module.

All group members work with other members of the group:

- to create a presentation of the content in VoiceThread and to narrate their parts,
- to compile materials and resources for the module,
- to facilitate the discussion in coordination with the Discussion Leader, and
- to work with the other members of the group to assist in their roles and responsibilities.
